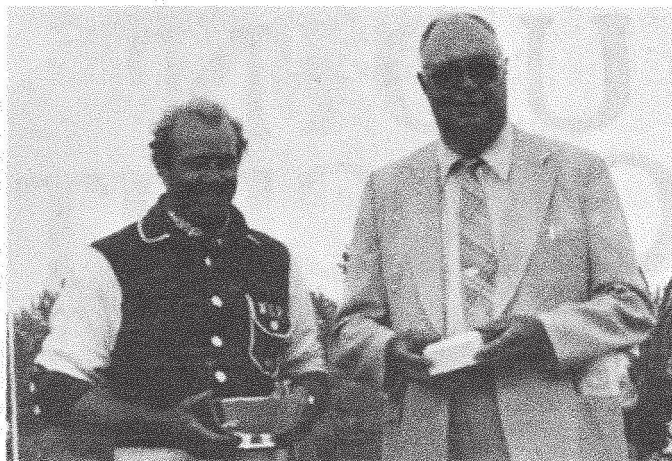

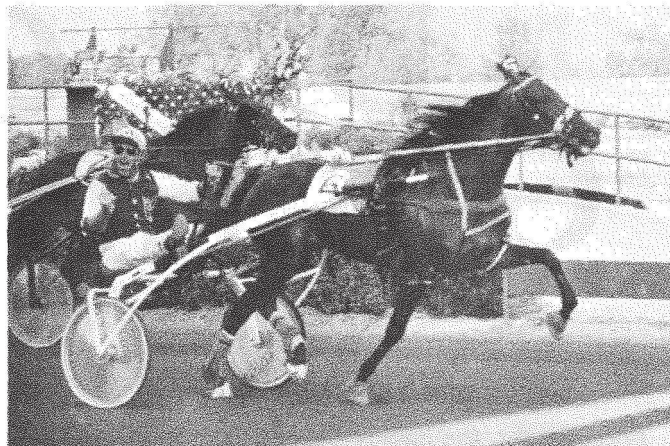


Presentations following Princess Glory's triumph in the Hambletonian 3-year-old filly trot were made to the Noble Gesture filly's trainer Bill Popfinger by Max C. Hempt, president of the Hambletonian Society.

Arnold Bachner's Kading, with Billy Haughton in the sulky. Tommy finished third with Kentuckiana Farm's Miss Dogwood in back of Princess Glory in the 1:58 $\frac{4}{5}$ trip.

Miss Dogwood was a late scratch in the second mile in which Kading once again set the pace. The bay daughter of Hickory Pride-Noccalula repulsed a bid around the three-quarters by Joop Jacob's celebrated Greatest Action, driven by Jan Johnson, but then was caught herself in the stretch by Princess Glory, who reached the wire a length in front in 1:57 $\frac{4}{5}$ for Bill Popfinger, who also trains the bay daughter of Noble Gesture-New Glory for Ed Powell and S. Geoffrion.

Princess Glory grabbed the lead at the start of their race-off, and never relinquished it. A final quarter in :27 $\frac{3}{5}$ kept Kading at bay, although by only a neck at the wire.

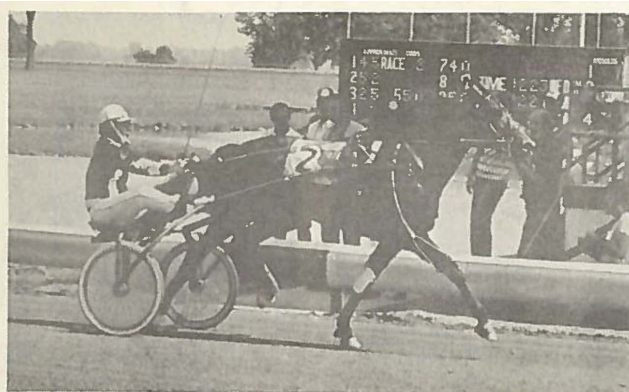

The Hambletonian Filly Stake in 1978 found Cora T., a three-quarter sister to two Hambletonian winners, Christopher T. and Timothy T., finding her way to Victory Lane also. Owners Don Miller and John Thro sent the light bay filly into the race as a slight favorite and the filly took the first heat in 1:58, only to lose the second to the very fast Rosemary. But Cora T. prevailed in the final, getting up in the final eighth of a mile to collar Rosemary and earn herself a nice chunk of cash plus almost limitless value as a broodmare.

In 1977, another classic duel between two great fillies developed. Superlou, a daughter of 1972 Hambletonian winner, Super Bowl, and Elmsford, a daughter of 1969 Hambletonian winner, Lindy's Pride, battled out three tough heats with Elmsford carrying home the trophy for Ferme Grade, Inc. and Henri Filion, both of Canada. Filion trained and drove the filly to her wins with a first heat score in 1:57 3-5 over Nobie Hanover and Superlou. A claim of foul cost the Lindy's Pride filly the second heat, with Superlou the adjudged winner in 1:57 4-5 before Elmsford returned to take the final in 2:15 2-5, the final quarter trotted in :28 seconds. The purse was a record \$65,686.

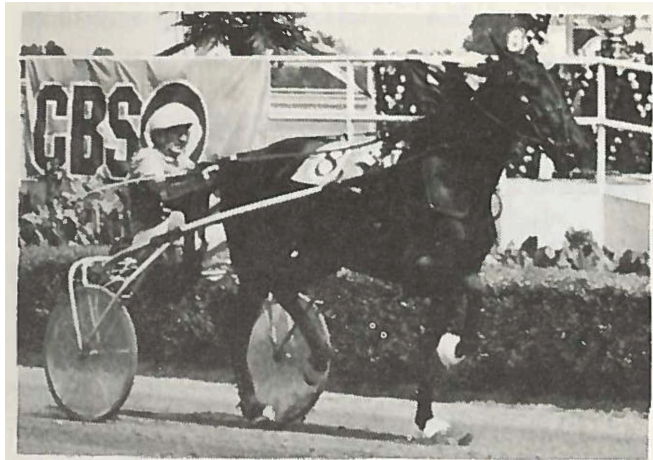

In 1976, for the second straight year, a daughter of Hickory Pride took the filly stake honors in what has become considered one of the classic filly races of all time. Ima Lula, the big filly owned by Duncan MacDonald and Japa, Charlotte Sheppard and John Simpson, Sr.'s daughter of Star's Pride, battled out three fantastic heats. Ima Lula took the initial heat with a short 1:57 4-5 victory over Japa, while the gummy fillies battled to the wire in the second heat in 1:56 3-5 with Japa earning a new world filly mark. The third heat saw the final quarter trotted in :27 1-5 seconds as two of the finest fillies in the history of the sport did battle with Ima Lula prevailing by a long neck to garner the \$60,474 purse.

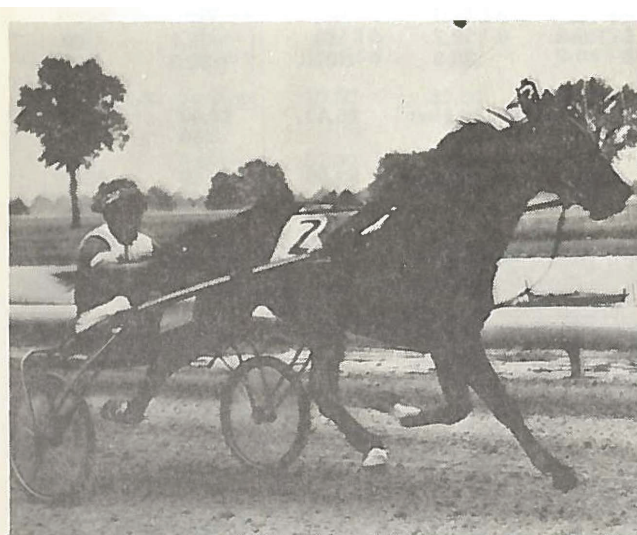

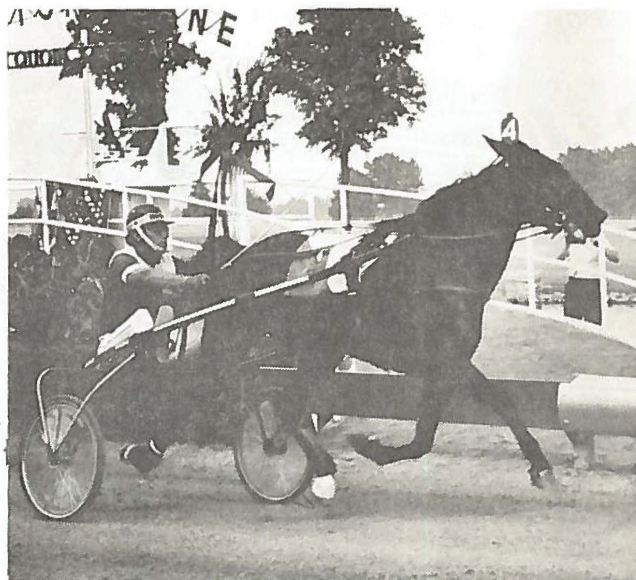
